

Decisions of the Council of the Doctoral School of Applied Informatics and Applied Mathematics

Decision No 194

Decision No 194.: For the first (autumn) semester of the academic year 2024/25, on the basis of the proposal made by the Admissions Committee, decisions were taken by the President of the EDHT, which resulted in the rejection of certain applicants, with the proviso that they could apply to the Rector for a fairness request for their admission.

One of the applicants, László Tóth (Topic: "Artificial Intelligence Techniques in Quality Risk Assessment and Management in Software Development Process", original topic leader: Dr. Zsolt Csaba Johanyák) made use of this possibility.

The Rector accepted his reques, but indicated that in order to continue his studies, according to our current regulations¹, an "internal" subject leader must be appointed, since Dr. Zsolt Csaba Johanyák works full-time at the Neumann János University in Kecskemét, and only has a second job at the University of Óbuda.

To solve this problem, the DIT President indicated that the DIT could appoint Dr. József Tar as the internal subject leader, who could assist the external subject leader and monitor the student's professional progress². The Rector found this proposal to be an appropriate solution, which is

Teachers, topic authors, topic leaders of the doctoral school 12. §

(4) The head of a doctoral topic shall be a lecturer or researcher holding an academic degree, whose topic has been approved by the Council of the Doctoral School and who, on the basis of this approval, is responsible for supervises and supports the studies and research work of the doctoral student working on the topic, and the preparation of doctoral students for the award of a doctoral degree (Article 13(5) of Decree 387/2012 Coll.).

A subject supervisor shall be responsible for the supervision of no more than six doctoral students who have not obtained theirs absolutory.

(5) A doctoral student may have two subject supervisors at the same time, subject to the approval of the doctoral school council. The name of the supervisor or supervisors shall be clearly indicated on the title page of the doctoral thesis (Article 13(6) of DIT Regulation No. 387/2012 Coll.). In addition to the external supervisor, the DIT shall appoint an internal supervisor who shall assist the external supervisor and monitor the student's professional progress. In the case of two subject leaders, the DIT appoints a responsible subject leader.
