

Decisions of the Council of the Doctoral School of Applied Informatics and Applied Mathematics

Decision No 208

Resolution No. 208/1: The Council of the Doctoral School of Applied Informatics and Applied Mathematics puts forward the initiation of the habilitation procedure to the MTTDHT (Doctoral and Habilitation Council for Engineering and Natural Sciences) in the case of Dr. Gábor Kertész PhD and proposes the following committee:
